### Science Fair Participant Information 4th-5th Grade

#### Display Boards

- Refer to page 12 in your Science Fair Planning Guide for guidelines and an example of how to put your display board together. Remember the display board is the last thing you want to do. Make sure you have all parts completed and laid out before you attach anything to your board.

#### Turning Your Experiment In

- 4th and 5th grade experiments are **DUE Wednesday, 4/16/25**. Please deliver your completed backboard and any display items to Portable #32 before school starts. Portable #32 will be open from 7:30-8:00 am.

#### Judging

- 4th and 5th Grade Judging will take place **Wednesday, 4/16/25** during the school day. Students will be released from class/or present their experiment to the Judges at lunch or recess.
- 4th and 5th graders please don't stress about judging! Relax and have fun. We can't wait to hear about your experiment!
- Students in 4th and 5th grade will have the chance to showcase their projects to our friendly team of "judges" who will offer constructive feedback. This provides students with an opportunity to formally present their work and address any inquiries. All students will be evaluated impartially, with top presentations and projects receiving Gift Certificates and medals. Like their younger counterparts, each student will also receive a participation certificate.

#### Science Fair

- The Science Fair will take place **Thursday, 4/17/25 from 5:00 - 7:00 pm** in the MPR. This is the same night as open house!
- There will be a short ceremony to announce all grade level winners at 6:45pm in Portable #32.

**\*Grades TK-3 will turn in their project the morning of the fair Thursday, 4/17/25.**
